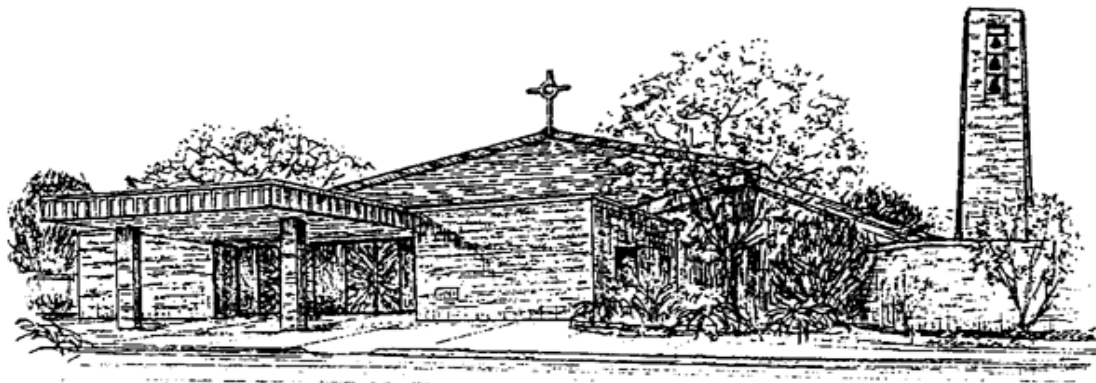

**The 20/20 Project**

You may have seen these car magnets and wondered what they mean. This past March, LIFENET, New Jersey Right to Life, and other pro-life organizations were able to get both houses of the NJ legislature to sponsor the "Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act". The goal

is to ban abortions after 20 weeks by the year 2020. All biological indicators show that babies in the womb as young as 20 weeks are capable of feeling pain. The United States is one of seven countries worldwide that permit elective abortions at 20 weeks and beyond. Fifteen states have passed legislation making abortion illegal after 20 weeks. Unlike these states, New Jersey permits abortion at all stages of gestation.

This is an effort to humanize pre-born babies, give them rights, and establish once and for all their humanity. The Catholic Church has been the main force against abortion since Christ came into the world. There are three things we can do to ban abortions at 20 weeks and eventually altogether. They are:

1. Pray to end abortion.
2. Contact your New Jersey State Senator and two members of the Assembly and ask them to support and co-sponsor bill A3452/S2026. Visit [njleg.state.nj.us](http://njleg.state.nj.us) to find your representatives.
3. Request Masses for this intention: "For the protection of babies in the womb and their families". The Mass and the Holy Eucharist are the principal sources of grace in the world and the surest way to end abortion. Our goal is to have 2,400 Masses offered throughout New Jersey.
